comprehensive plan is complete. Any questions can be presented at next P&Z meeting schedule in April 2020.

A sample of the questions that will be in the survey were asked to the board.

- Why do they like living in Haw River?
- What do they dislike in Haw River?
- What do they wish for Haw River?
- What would be your greatest fear in Haw River?
- What is priority #1 (one) facing this community, if "you" were in charge?

The Town has Online surveys which will close 2 weeks from today.
